



VOTING AT THE FIAP GENERAL ASSEMBLY

FIAP statutes stipulate that each national association, member of FIAP and having paid its membership fee, is entitled to one vote at the General Assembly.

You can make use of your right to vote in two different ways:

1) by sending a delegation

Each federation is free in the choice of its delegates and of their number, but the number of delegates taking an active part in the administrative sessions will not be larger than three. Each delegation can have only one spokesman; he must be in possession of the official voting card.

It is required that the members of the delegations of the federations be either nationals of or persons residing in the member-country and also are members of that federation.

2) by giving proxy to another operational member

No delegation may represent more than two countries besides its own and can therefore have three votes at the most.

NBM Voting by correspondence is not allowed by the FIAP statutes.
