INVITATION

ÖVF-Österreichischer Verband der Fotografie organizes, under the Patronage of the FIAP Youth Service, the 40th FIAP Youth Digital in 2020 and invites young authors of all countries, member of FIAP, to participate in this Youth contest.

CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

Each national association member of FIAP may enter 20 digital works (max.2 works per author) per section:

- a) Traditional photos (Cameras)
- b) Mobile phones or smart phone photos

WORKS SIZE

Files for the projection and for the creation of a catalogue will be JPG format, 10 or 8 compression and bigger, minimum size 2400 pixels. All styles and creative techniques are allowed. The images files and the completed entry form must be uploaded exclusively at the FIAP organizer youth biennial internet portal.

The entrant must use the western alphabet for submitting an entry with the country name followed by a number 01 to 10 (to 20) and it is not allowed to use designations such as "no title" unnamed etc.(example: IRELAND01.jpg, IRELAND02.jpg, etc.)

The images must have a photographic origin. The authors must detain all the rights of their images as a whole and for every part thereof.

They permit the publication related to the projection (exhibition) of their images free of charge. This may include low resolution posting on a website.

WARNING: Nude works are strictly forbidden !

JUDGEMENT

The works in each of the two age categories and sections will be judged separately by a renowned jury and be ordered from the FIAP Youth Service Director with the Organizer. The judgement will be carried out according to the instructions of FIAP, with no right of appeal. The jury members from different countries must understand the latest photo shooting and photo techniques, which is frequently being used by today's youth.

Category I. up to the age of 16 (born after 15.09.2004)

Category II. up to the age of 21 (born after 15.09.1999)

PRIZES

The Biennial for each sections will be awarded as follows:

World Cup Awards offered by the organizer and sponsors for the best national federation.

FIAP Gold medal for the federation which comes second.

FIAP Silver medal for the federation which comes third.

FIAP Bronze medal for the federation which comes fourth.

FIAP diplomas for the federations which come 5th to 7th.

All the authors of the federation coming to the World Cup receive diplomas.

One FIAP gold, two silver and tree bronze medal will award works of exceptional quality, independently of the federations` classification in each sections.

Each author can only receive one prize.

One CEWE Award will be awarded by the organizing country in each section and category

CATALOGUE

The catalogue will be produced with all awarded images and a wide selection of the accepted images, along side the list of all the accepted images per country and the list of award-winning authors. (The CD can be produced with a programme allowing it to work with no difficulty).

The catalogue (CD) will show the FIAP logo on the cover with the appropriate Biennial number. On the CD all the compulsory statistics about the salon must be recorded.

The author agrees that his images may be published in a catalogue and on an Internet WEB page free of charge. The images will not be used in a commercial context. There is no possibility of recourse to legal action.
