INVITATION

On behalf of the International Federation of Photographic Art, Photo club Novi Sad invites authors of all countries, member of FIAP to participate in the 18th Nature Biennial. It will take place in Novi Sad, Serbia from 1th July to 15th August 2016.

CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

There are two categories: PRINTS (black & white and/or colour) and PROJECTED IMAGES (Files). Each national association, Operational Member of FIAP, may enter **10 PRINTS** black & white and/or colour (at most 1 print per author) and **20 PROJECTED IMAGES** (at most 2 per author). Each collection must be coherent from the point of view of **inspiration and conception** as well as from the point of view of **realisation and presentation**. Each federation chooses its subject and its choice of entries. The prints must have a format 30x40cm. Smaller prints must be mounted on a light support 30x40cm (12"x16"). The files for Projected Images must be JPG10, 72 dpi and 2400 pixels minimum for the large side, in order to be printed. Files will be named with the **FIAP members' code** followed by a number from 01 to 20 and the work title (example : N01_01_snow.jpg, N01_02_trees.jpg, etc.).  The authors of the federation coming first receive an honourable mention
